**International Film Festival Agrofilm 2015 was full of flavours** 

Thirty first International Film Festival Agrofilm 2015 offered films full of flavours and

experience during the whole week. They were appreciated by audience in six places of

screening, during 143 screenings as well as by the international and special jury.

The international jury, consisting of filmmakers as well as agricultural experts,

evaluated the films from the viewpoint of the idea of the festival and at the same time strictly

scrutinised the filmmaker quality. After long discussions and hard work both juries ended up

awarding 15 prizes in total.

Film Global menu of Hungarian production was awarded the Grand Agrofilm Prize.

The audience had the opportunity to view this film in all screening places (NPPC Lužianky,

UCF Nitra, SUA Nitra, TU Zvolen, and Shopping Centre Mlyny Nitra) repeatedly during the

festival week. The film provides a comprehensive view of the changes in agriculture and food

industry during the last century, and it shows these changes in an attractive way that is

acceptable to most viewers.

The Austrian producer obtained the Prize of the Minister of Agriculture and Rural

Development of the Slovak Republic for his film Land Grabbing. The film highlights

increased demand for agricultural land and questions the practices of investors.

Not only the jury but also the viewers appreciated the French Film Steak (R)evolution

and the Hungarian document Story of the Mangalitsa, which made their mouths water.

The document by Štefan Val'a *Draining of Soils = Climate Change* was awarded by

the jury as the best Slovak film. The author shows the threat of devastation of soil and offers a

way to stop it.

The festival once again confirmed that it is possible to create interesting films of high

quality in such specific sphere as agriculture and nutrition, which open our eyes as consumers

and help us to navigate in the huge amount of superficial information.
